





Vulnerability disclosure policy Working with security issues in an open source project can be challenging, as we are required to disclose potential problems that could be exploited by attackers. With this in mind, our security fix policy is as follows: 1. The Maintainers team will handle the fix as usual (Pull Request, backport, release). 2. In the release notes, we will include the identification numbers from the GitHub Advisory Database (GHSA) and, if applicable, the Common Vulnerabilities and Exposures (CVE) identifier for the vulnerability. 3. We will provide a grace period of 2 months for implementers to update to a patched version. In the case of critical security issues, the grace period will be extended to 4 months. 4. Once this grace period has passed, we will publish the vulnerability. 


Design System (in progress - blocks)

 Commenters, in turn, receive notifications and have the ability to accept or decline their coauthorship.








Total income in 2024 are higher than planned in both scenarios, realistic and ideal (4% higher than the maximum forecast)




Total expenses are between the forecasts in both scenarios, although closer to the realistic scenario (20% higher)




The financial result of 2024 allows the Association to increase the amount of last year's positive cash flow, ending the year with a reserve that would allow the financing of 5 months' fixed costs

Evolution in the distribution of income sources




Ideal distribution outlined in the sustainability plan



5. Presentation of the election process of the Coordination Committee

- The Coordination Committee manages and represents the Association
- This is a honorary position, estimated dedication of 10 hours per month
- Attributions are set in Article 20 of the statues

Why be a part of the Committee?

- Help in stewardship of the Decidim project
- Ensure the values of the project are upheld in any decisions
- Contribute to the growth and expansion of the project

5. Presentation of the election process of the Coordination Committee

- At least 3 members must be elected* but more can get in
- At least 40% of the Committee must be composed by women
- There is currently 2 women and 4 men. Per the statutes:
 - Committee must be composed of at least 9 people up to 21
 - To maintain the percentage of women, a correction process is made. If, according to the election, less than 40% women are voted, the man with the least amount of votes will be discarded in favor of the woman with the more amount of votes, until the composition is at least 40%

6. Presentation of the design process of the internal rules 2025



What's the status?

- For those of you with a good memory, we already announced this process at our Annual General Meeting in April
- ... But we prioritized other matters, and now it's the big comeback!



Internal regulation is needed

- Lack of regulation on how to decide on political issues
- Making our own governance more actionable
- Some entities mentioned in the statutes have never been created
- Clarify the role of existing entities



Subjects affected by the internal regulation

- Can concern all aspects that are not expressly regulated in the statutes (Art. 7)
- Procedure for electing the members of the Coordination Committee and its officers, in general or in case of vacancies (Art. 18.4 y 19.2)
- Request for the creation, composition, and establishment of thematic committees (Art. 25)
- Procedure for the election of the Democratic Guarantees Committee (Art. 30.4)
- Procedures for sanctioning inappropriate or malicious behaviour by members (Art. 30.1)
- Requirements to become a member of the Association (Art. 36.2)



So, what now?

- 1. Who's up to participate in the drafting committee and propose a first draft?
- 2. Drafting committee works on a document during 2 months
- 3. Discussions on the draft on Metadecidim
- 4. Review of the contributions
- 5. Merge and publication of the draft v.2
- 6. Meeting to discuss divergences
- 7. Publish the final text
- 8. Approve it (or not) in the next general assembly
