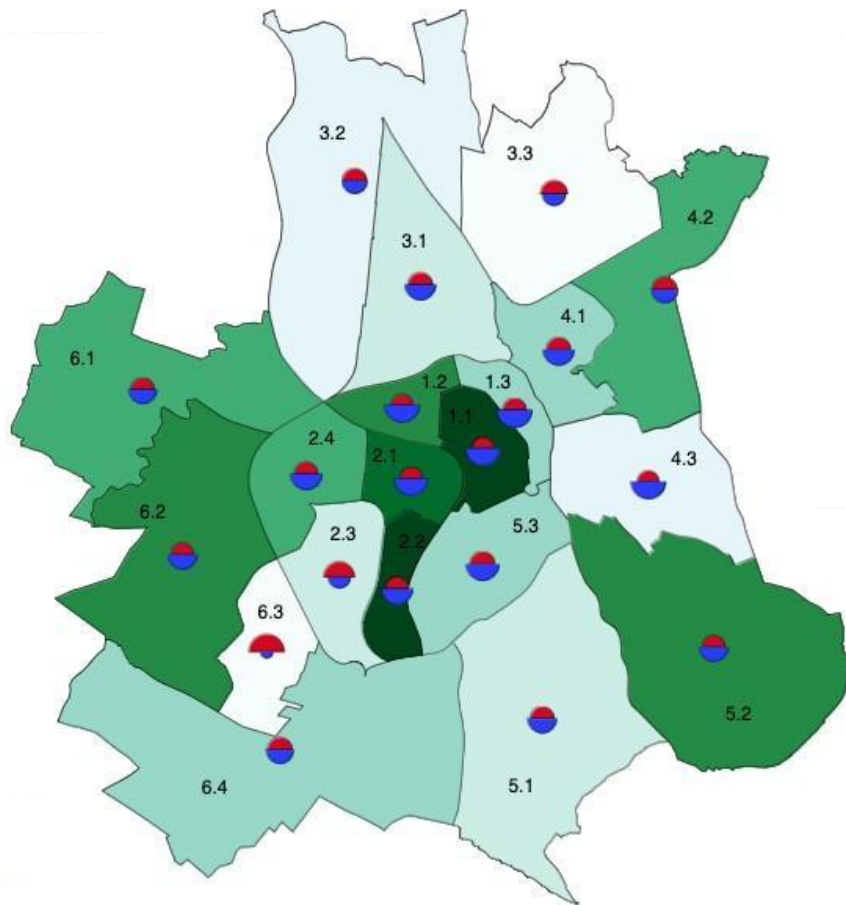
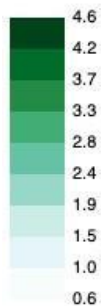

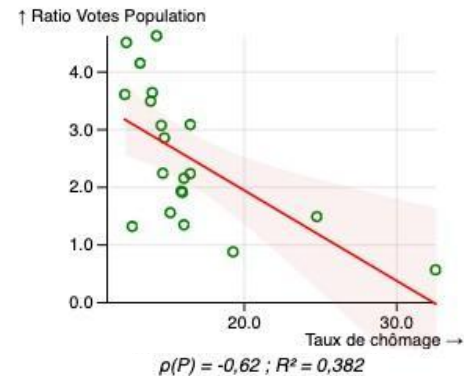
Unemployment
rate



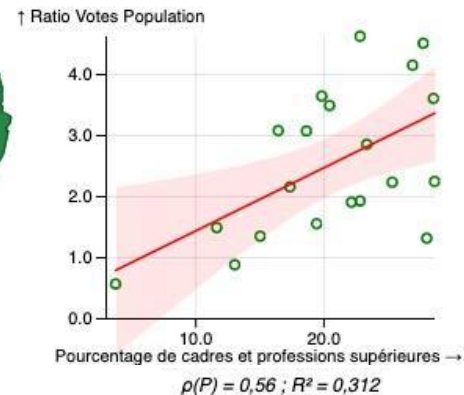
Percentage of

workers



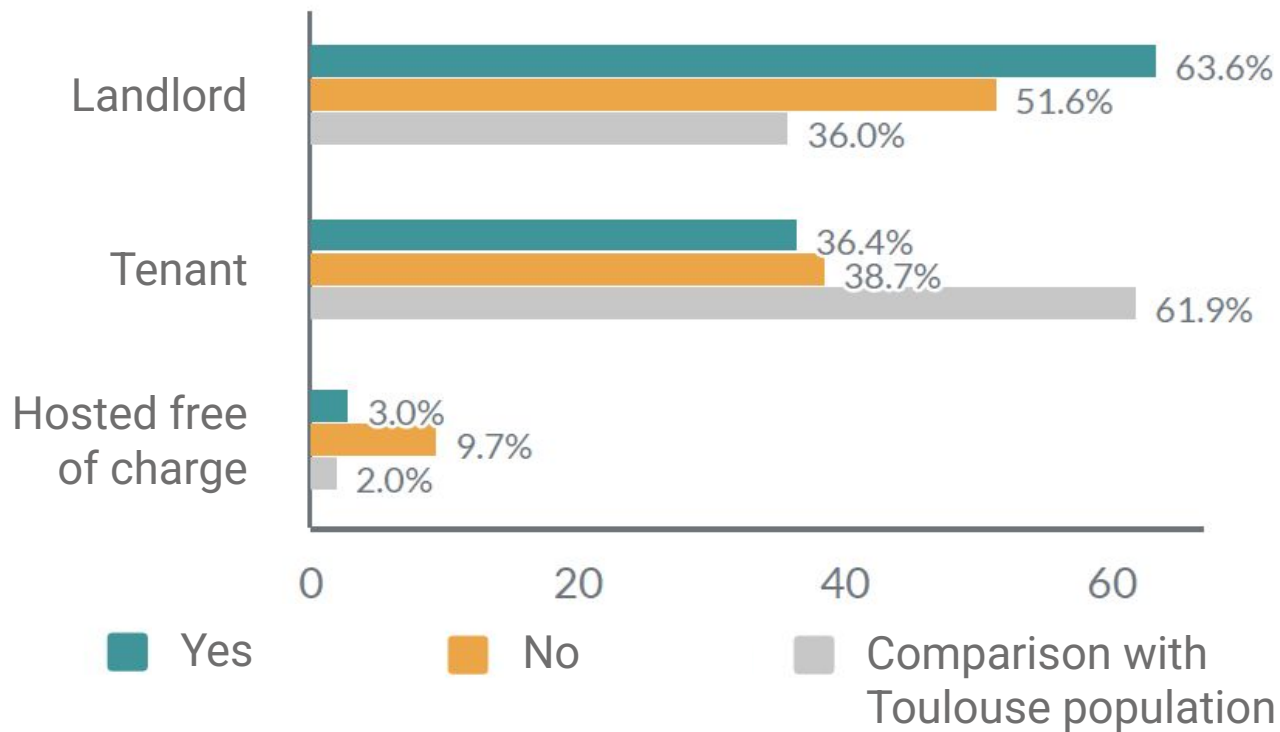
Unemployment rate -

Votes/100 inhabitants

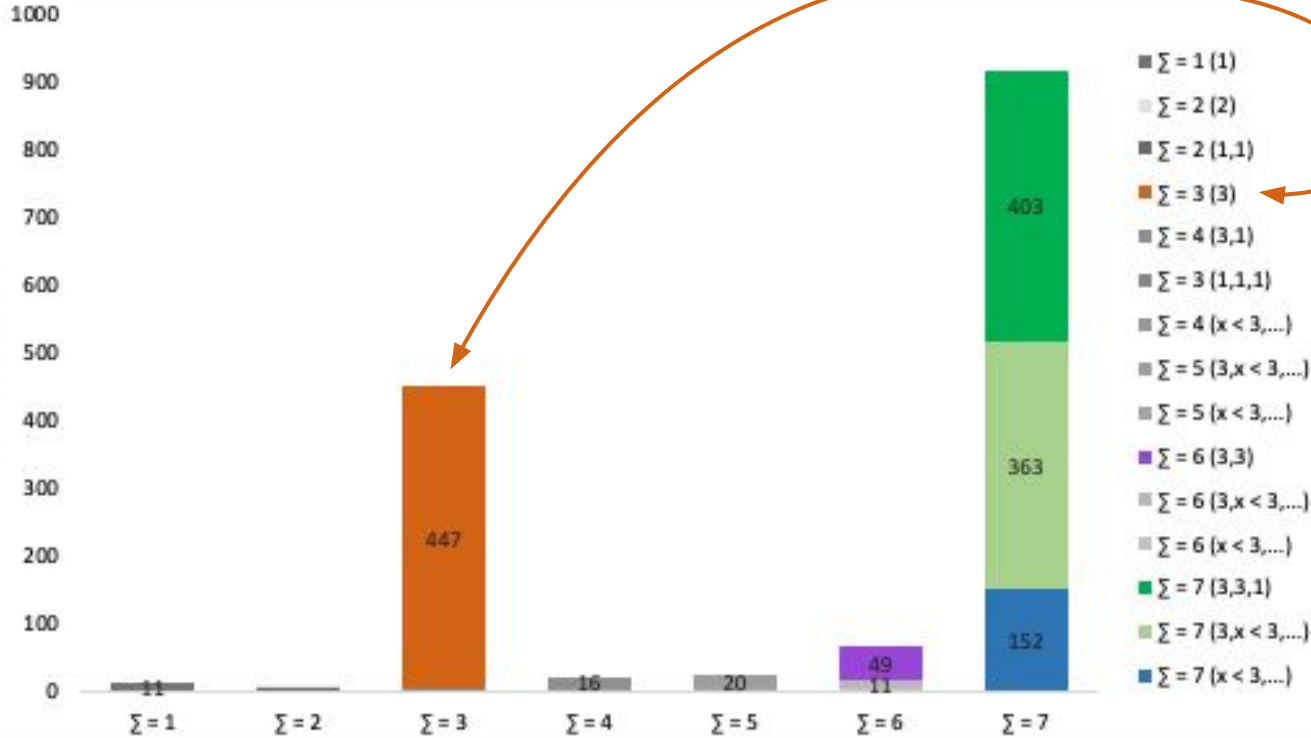

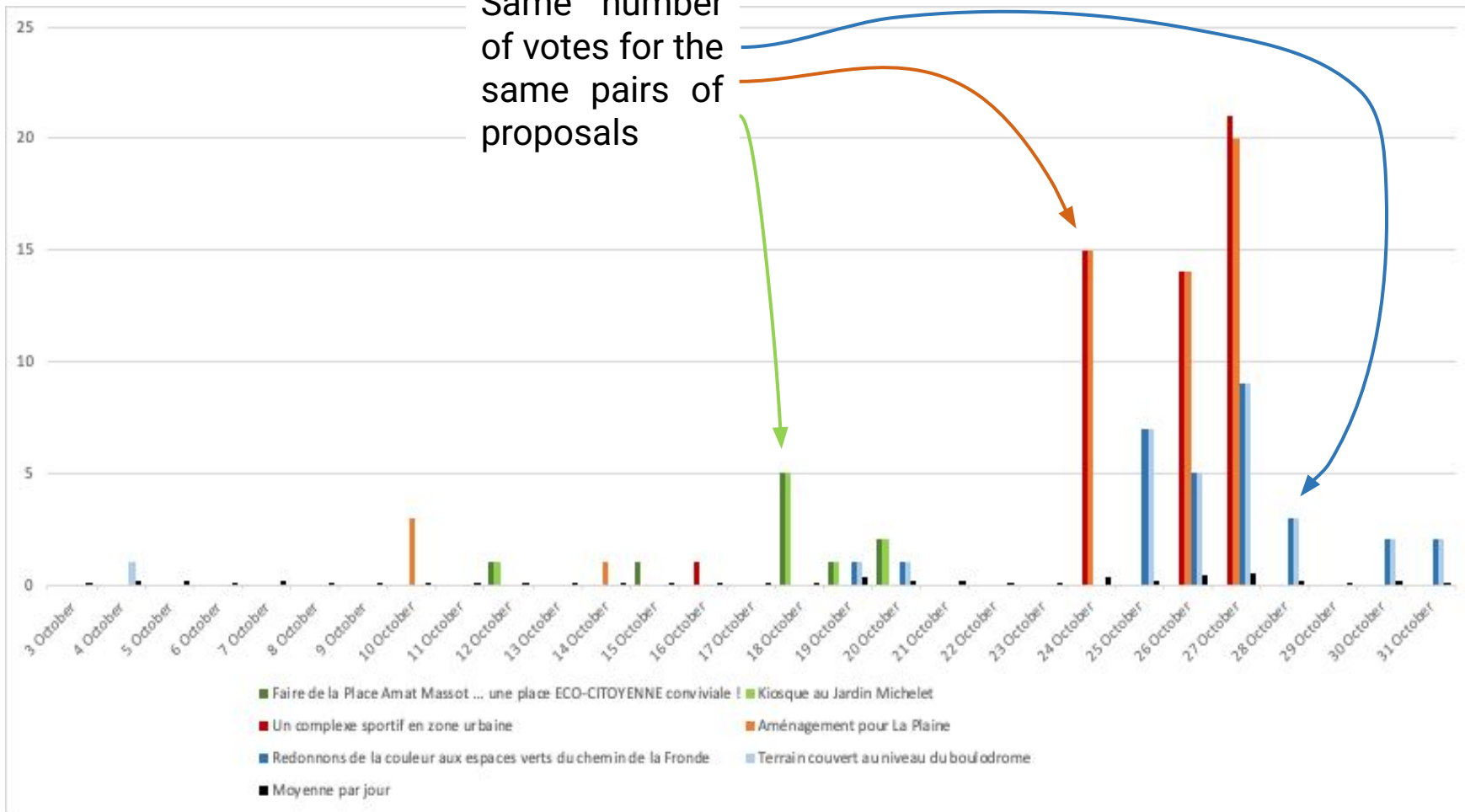
